Candidates Day Kiwanis Trustees

Once a year, we have the privilege and responsibility of electing five of our members as Trustees of our Club. Their election signifies their commitment to provide Kiwanis leadership for the duration of their two-year term that begins on October 1. Today's meeting is an annual tradition, whereby the candidates are formally presented to our Club, as their names are individually placed in nomination via skits, witty speeches and other forms of presentation. Below are photos and brief biographies of the individuals the Nominating Committee, headed by Past President Jim Skidmore, has recommended.

Jim Shively - Jim has been a member of the Kiwanis Club of Columbus for 34 years. In that time he has served various committees including: Homeless; Public Relations; Behavioral Health & Wellness; Make-a-Difference Day; Centennial and others. He has served two terms as a Club Trustee and if elected, he will go through the Club officer chairs with anticipation of becoming Club President during the 2018-19 administrative year.



Jim is the sole proprietor of Larry Phillips Photography and he has generously given of his time and talent to provide us with photos at every major Club event, including family pictures for the homeless community at the Good Neighbors Picnic and at Bethlehem on Broad; photos of the Regatta and individual contestants; candid photos at the Columbus International 5K; photos at the annual ACC Father/Daughter Dance; individual member photos for the Club Directory and web site; and much more.



Brian Seitz - Brian has been an active Kiwanian since 2006. Along with sitting on the Columbus International 5K committee since its inception, Brian co-chaired the Auction Committee in 2008 and chaired the Scholarship Committee from 2010 – 2013.

Brian is the founder of Ten Penny Design, a small boutique design firm located in downtown Columbus. Formed in 2007, the Ten Penny Design team realizes their strongest asset is their ability to assemble quickly and bring their 25+ years of experiences in the architecture and design industry together to tackle any design challenge. Brian and his team thrive on a challenge, which is apparent based on a broad client list consisting of hospitality leaders, healthcare providers and retail giants. One of his most memorable achievements was the establishment and maintenance of an Aktion Club in Crawford County with the County Board of Developmental Disabilities.

Caitlyn Nestleroth - Caitlyn is an associate assistant Attorney General in the Office of the Ohio Attorney General Mike DeWine. She is a member of the Healthcare Fraud Section, where she prosecutes healthcare providers who fraudulently overbill Ohio's Medicaid program. A Westerville native, Caitlyn is a graduate of Ohio Wesleyan University and the Ohio State University Moritz College of Law. She is an alumna of both Key Club and Circle K.



Caitlyn joined the Kiwanis Club of Columbus in the fall of 2011. She is an active member of the Homeless committee and regularly volunteers at Manna Café, the Furniture Bank of Central Ohio, Bethlehem on Broad Street and the Good Neighbors Picnic. She has also lent her vocal talents to the last four Presidents' parties.



Wes Strickling - Wes is the founder of Codex Techworks, a healthcare information technology firm specializing in the unique needs and challenges of the eye care industry. Wes began his business in 2004, at the forefront of the start-up industry boom, and continues to run a successful and growing business today. Even with employees in multiple regions of the country, Wes operates his small business more like a family business. With their support he is able to maintain the entrepreneurial mentality his business was built upon and to focus primarily on business development and growth opportunities.

- 1- *Trustee elections will be held at our May 16 luncheon meeting conducted by the Past Presidents' Fraternity. Once elected, these candidates will take office on October 1, 2016, and will serve through September 30, 2018.*
- 2- *The five current Trustees who will serve along with these candidates for the first year are Chad Endsley, Kristin Gintz, Bill Calvert, Arnold Barzak and Leslie Huntington.*
- 3- *The five candidates to be elected in May of 2017 will serve their first term with these candidates and their second term with the candidates elected in 2018.*
- 4- *Completing their Trustee responsibilities (this September 30) will be Pranab Bhattacharya, David Kandel, JP LaFramboise and Jack D'Aurora.*
- 5- *Immediately following the Club meeting on Monday, May 9, the five newly elected Trustees, plus the five who will be serving with them during the 2016-17 administrative year, will meet and elect Club officers. It is expected that Jack D'Aurora will move into the Club presidency on October 1, 2016, and Chad Endsley will serve as Club president-elect during the 2016-17 administrative year.
