He was elected to this position in July 2000. With an emphasis on financial discipline and an improved corporate culture, Jurgensen has led Nationwide to high levels of performance.

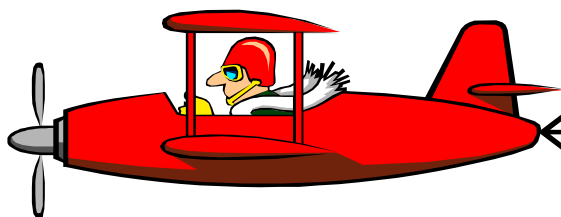
During his tenure, Nationwide's net income has increased from \$138 million in 2001 to more than \$1 billion in 2004 and 2005.

He also serves on the board of directors for ConAgra Foods, Inc.

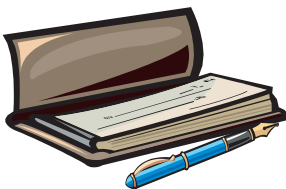
